SIMILIA-SIMILIBUS –CURANTUR

Homeopathy is a Greek word (homo=similar, pathy=suffering) literally meaning similar suffering. It is a system of medicine which treats not the disease but the person with the disease by the use of natural substances that when administered to a healthy person in crude dose, produce symptoms similar to the condition for which he is being treated. A small, often infinitesimal dose of a substance can stimulate the body's own healing abilities to affect a deep and long lasting-cure. Homeopathy according to Doctor Samuel Hahnemann is based on the law of similar similibus curantur or 'let likes cure likes'. Recorded into the work of Paracelus the father of chemical medicine, this postulate was foreseen in ancient Greece by Hyprocrites the father of medicine.

In the nineteen century, Dr. Samuel Hahnemann a German physician further developed homeopathy into a define system of medicine. In his lifetime he cured many complicated diseases, which were

incurable by other upon) Methods with the help of homeopathic medicines. Homeopathy has a very rich history in North America
During the nineteenth century many Master Homeopaths created a path to what we have today.
